

# RACE HISTORY

The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup started out as the Queen's Silver Jubilee Challenge Cup, a 2230m handicap staged at Happy Valley in 1977 to celebrate the Silver Jubilee of Britain's Queen Elizabeth II. The distance and class of the race changed many times throughout the first 20 years until in 1997 it became a terms event over a mile. In 2000, the Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup ("Challenge" was dropped from the race title in 1989) was upgraded to HKG3 level; two years later the contest achieved HKG2 status and in 2006 it was upgraded to HKG1 level. The race distance was shortened to the current distance of 1400m in 2005. The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup was ranked equal 19th in the list of World's Top 100 G1 races in 2019.

The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup is now the second leg of the Hong Kong Speed Series, falling between the G1 Centenary Sprint Cup (first leg - 1200m) and G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize (final leg - 1200m). Able Friend produced a sensational win in this race in 2015 that placed the brilliant chestnut at the top of the LONGINES World's Best Racehorse Rankings. Beauty Generation, Hong Kong's Horse of the Year for the past two seasons, completed back-to-back victories in last year's renewal. Other past winners of the race include standout champions Ambitious Dragon, Lucky Nine, Good Ba Ba, Electronic Unicorn and the great Silent Witness, who notched his record 17th consecutive career win in this race in 2005. The race's prize money has increased to the current level of HK\$10 million in 2015.

# QUEEN'S SILVER JUBILEE CUP 2019

Beauty Generation made it two wins on the bounce in Hong Kong's only 1400m G1 contest, the Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup, taking his win streak for the season to six unblemished. The Horse of the Year broke cleanly for Zac Purton and settled outside of Beat The Clock and Rattan before taking over at the 1000-metre mark. The dominant bay powered on to secure the winner's share of the HK\$10 million prize.

The Road To Rock gelding was sent off as the 1.2 favourite and motored clear under the Australian, staving off the challenge of the ever-consistent and improving Beat The Clock who had landed his first G1 victory the time before in the Centenary Sprint Cup (1200m), and would be crowned the season's Champion Sprinter. Trainer John Size had the second and third home, with Conte following the runner-up across the line.

"It's just a repeat of what he's been doing all season," trainer John Moore said.

Zac Purton added: "It was easy for him."

Beauty Generation's win was Moore's eighth in the race since the turn of the century following Goggles (2002), Joyful Winner (2006 & 2007), Happy Zero (2010), Able Friend (2015) and Helene Paragon (2017), while Purton snatched his third win with his two aboard Beauty Generation following Ambitious Dragon's sizzling score in 2013.



# RACE HISTORY

It's more than four decades since the Hong Kong Gold Cup was inaugurated at Sha Tin Racecourse. In that time, a host of Hong Kong racing's equine greats have carried off the Cup and today the contest is an international Group 1 race worth HK\$10 million. The victory roll features standouts such as River Verdon, Indigenous, Bullish Luck, Vengeance Of Rain, Viva Pataca, Ambitious Dragon, Military Attack, Designs On Rome, Werther and Time Warp. Notable among the race's early winners are Silver Lining, Co-Tack, Gay Eighties and Yuno When, but the distinction of being the first ever Hong Kong Gold Cup winner will forever belong to Observatory, trained by Allan Chan and ridden by the great Pat Eddery, who took the spoils on 14 January, 1979.

That initial contest was an 1800m affair and it was not until 1993 that the race distance changed to its now familiar 2000m. One year earlier the race was granted HKG1 status and formed the second leg of the newly-established Hong Kong Triple Crown, sandwiched between the Stewards' Cup (1600m) and Champions & Chater Cup (2400m). Citi Group has sponsored the Hong Kong Gold Cup since 2008.

River Verdon won the first HKG1 edition in 1992 and proceeded to rattle off a hat-trick of Gold Cup wins - a feat unmatched by any horse to date. His 1993 triumph was the middle leg of a famous Triple Crown triumph, the first and only in Hong Kong racing history.

John Moore is the winning-most trainer, having won the Hong Kong Gold Cup on 12 occasions, including nine since 2006. Tony Cruz also has eight wins in the race, twice as a jockey and six as a trainer, including Time Warp and Exultant in the past two years. The race's winning-most riders are Darren Beadman, Basil Marcus and Zac Purton with three wins apiece.

# CITI HONG KONG GOLD CUP 2019

Exultant justified 2.1 favouritism to secure the HK\$10 million G1 Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup in dominant style. The Tony Cruz-trained gelding sat off the pace early as siblings Time Warp and Glorious Forever drove forward to set a sizzling tempo. But jockey Zac Purton decided to take control when Vincent Ho slowed the pace on Time Warp and elected to take over at the 800-metre mark. Exultant rolled to the lead within 200m of being asked to advance and imposed his authority down the home straight to give Purton and Cruz back-to-back wins in the race, following Time Warp's 2018 success. It was Cruz's sixth win overall as a trainer thanks to Deauville (1997), Bullish Luck (2004), Perfect Partner (2005) and California Memory (2011) having also obliged.

"Zac rode a hell of a race, I thought Time Warp would go a hell of a pace but when Zac took off and went past him I just said 'holy mackerel!'" Cruz said.

Purton was matter-of-fact in his post-race analysis: "They were just going too slow but I knew my horse was the best stayer in the race and I knew he'd keep going – he just doesn't seem to get tired.

"He's got a lot stronger since this time last year and as a result he's just furnished into a better horse. We know what we've got now so I can use him and ride him accordingly."
