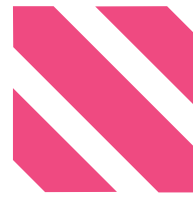

Bet tactics for Quinella and Quinella Place

Picking more than 2 horses can enhance
the chance of winning.

2 common tactics...

Banker:

When you think one of your favourite horses
has a higher chance of winning.



Multiple:

When you think your favourite horses have an
equal chance of winning.



Banker

A common way of placing a banker bet:
1 banker and 2 other selections.

Banker must appear in all possible
combinations.

Example:
No. 8 as banker and No. 2, 5 as other selections.



Real Case Example

29/05/2024 Sha Tin Race 3

This is a Class 4 1200M race. Customer A thinks that REGENT GLORY (No. 4) has a high chance of winning because he won over the same trip recently. Therefore, Customer A selects this horse as banker.

Also, MUST GO (No. 1) and DIAMOND FLARE (No. 7) have a good chance of finishing in the first-2 positions, as they are remaining runners in this race who had won in Class 4 over the same trip in this season.

Hence, he selects them as his other horses for the Quinella bet. Finally, MUST GO won the race and REGENT GLORY ran second. Customer A collected the dividend.

Banker

Another common way of placing a banker bet:
1 banker and 3 other selections.

Banker must appear in all possible combinations.

Example:
No. 8 as banker and No. 2, 5, 11 as other selections.



Real Case Example

28/04/2024 Sha Tin Race 2

Customer A thinks that VOYAGE SAMURAI (No. 7) has a high chance of winning because he finished in a first-2 position in last three starts. Therefore, Customer A selects this horse as banker.

Also, FRANTANCK (No. 2), UNIVERSAL HORIZON (No. 4) and KARMA (No. 6) have a good chance of finishing in the first-2 positions, as they are remaining runners in this race who have had wins in this season.

Hence, he selects them as his other horses for the Quinella bet. Finally, KARMA won the race and VOYAGE SAMURAI ran second. Customer A collected the dividend.

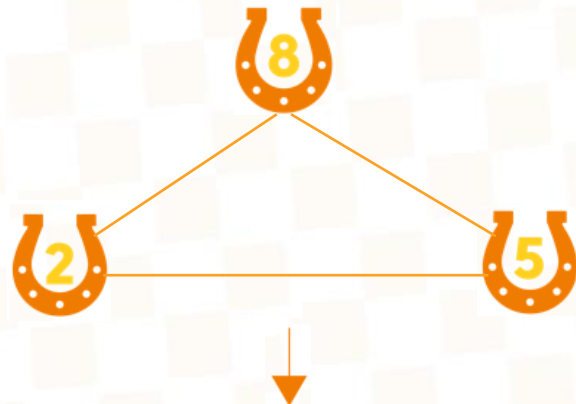

Multiple

A common way of placing a multiple bet:
Boxing 3 horses (total 3 combinations).

Selected horses are used to form all
possible combinations.

Example: Boxing No. 2, 5, 8.

Real Case Example

22/05/2024 Happy Valley Race 8

This is a Class 3 1650M race. Only RED HARE KING (No. 1), IVY LEAGUE (No. 3) and ROMANTIC LAOS (No. 6) had won in Class 3 over this trip in this season. Customer A thinks these 3 horses have an equal chance of winning.

Therefore, he bets on Quinella by multiple on the 3 selections. Finally, ROMANTIC LAOS won the race and RED HARE KING ran second. Customer A collected the dividend.

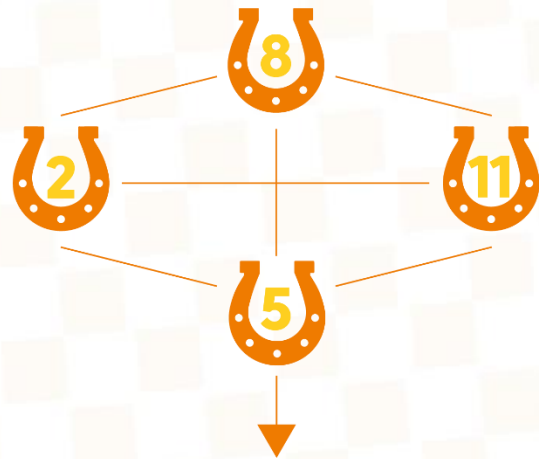

Multiple

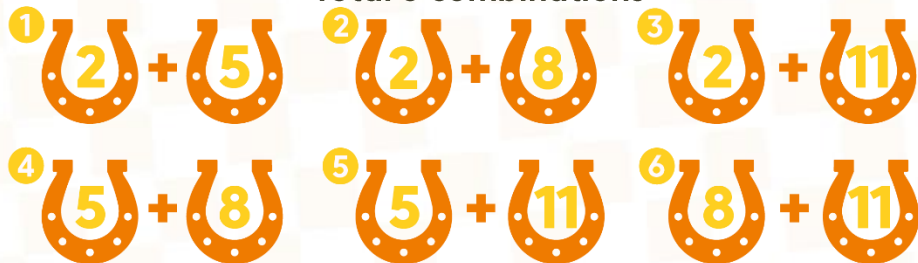
Another common way of placing a multiple bet:
Boxing 4 horses (total 6 combinations).

Selected horses are used to form all
possible combinations.

Example: Boxing No. 2, 5, 8, 11.

Real Case Example

01/07/2024 Sha Tin Race 4

This is a Class 3 1000M race. Only WE ARE HERO (No. 1), KA YING VICTORY (No. 3), PLEASANT ENDEAVOR (No. 4) and FLYING HIGH (No. 6) had won in Class 3 over the same trip. Customer A thinks these 4 horses have an equal chance of winning.

Therefore, he bets on Quinella by multiple on the 4 selections. Finally, FLYING HIGH won the race and WE ARE HERO ran second. Customer A collected the dividend.

Exotic Bets (Multi-race)



Double Trio

Pick the first three horses in any order in each of the two nominated races.

Example: Race 3 **6 - 7 - 9** + Race 4 **1 - 3 - 8**

Triple Trio

Pick the first three horses in any order in each of the three nominated races.

Example: Race 4 **6 - 7 - 9** + Race 5 **1 - 3 - 8** + Race 6 **2 - 5 - 12**

Triple Trio (Consolation): A consolation dividend is paid if the customer correctly picks the first three horses in the first two legs of the three nominated races.

Example: Race 4 **6 - 7 - 9** + Race 5 **1 - 3 - 8**

Double

Pick the winner in each of the two nominated races.

Example: Race 6 **2** + Race 7 **3**

Double (Consolation): A consolation dividend is paid if the customer picks the winner in the first nominated race, and the runner-up in the second nominated race.

Example: Race 6 **2** + Race 7 **8**

Treble

Available in the three nominated races of each race meeting.

Pick the winner in each of the three nominated races.

Example: Race 3 **7** + Race 4 **9** + Race 5 **8**

Treble (Consolation): A consolation dividend is paid if the customer picks the winner of the first two nominated races and the runner-up in the last nominated race.

Example: Race 3 **7** + Race 4 **9** + Race 5 **5**

Six Up

Available in the last 6 races of each race meeting.

Pick the 1st or 2nd horse in each of the six nominated races.

Example: Race 5 **7 or 3** + Race 6 **9 or 11** + Race 7 **8 or 5** +
Race 8 **6 or 2** + Race 9 **7 or 4** + Race 10 **2 or 9**

Six Win Bonus: Pick the winner in each of the six nominated races.

Example: Race 5 **7** + Race 6 **9** + Race 7 **8** + Race 8 **6** + Race 9 **7** + Race 10 **2**

Jockey Challenge

Jockeys earn Jockey Challenge points if they finish first, second or third in races.

Customers can collect a dividend when the selected jockey earns the most Jockey Challenge Points at a race meeting.

Jockey Challenge is a fixed odds bet. The dividend is calculated according to the odds fixed at the time the bet is accepted.

Trainer Challenge

Trainers earn Trainer Challenge points if their horses finish first, second or third in races.

Where a Trainer has more than one starter in a race, each of his first-3 placed starters will earn Trainer Challenge Points. A Trainer can earn at most 22 points in a race.

Customers can collect a dividend when the selected trainer earns the most Trainer Challenge Points at a race meeting.

Trainer Challenge is a fixed odds bet. The dividend is calculated according to the odds fixed at the time the bet is accepted.

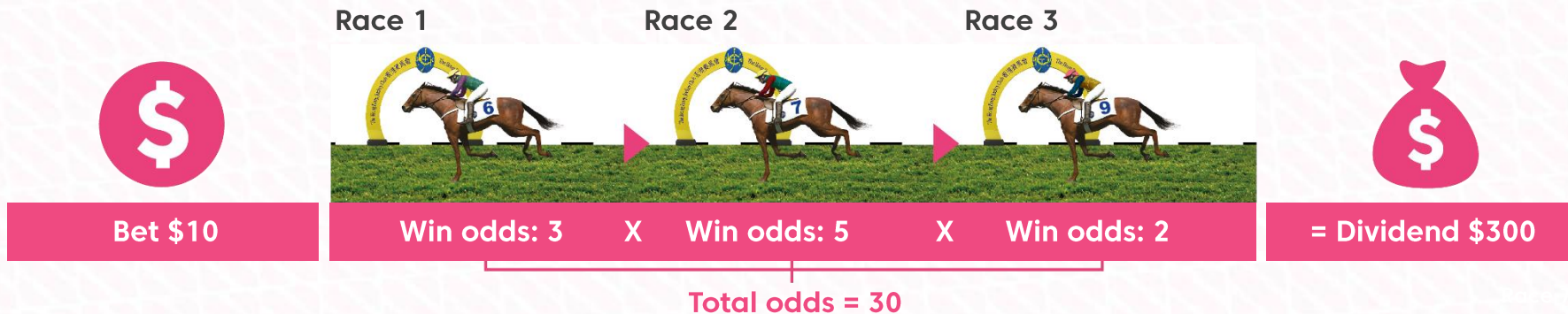


All Up

What is All Up?

All Up means placing bets on more than 1 race. Any dividend entitlement from a winning race will be automatically carried forward and reinvested in the subsequent race specified in the bet selection.

Example: All Up 3 x 1 Win



Customers can select the same or different betting pools for All Up.

Common All Up Betting Pools: Win, Place, Quinella, Quinella Place



All Up Formula

Choose the All Up Formula and number of combinations for 2 - 6 races.

Common All Up Formula



All Up Example (1): 2 X 3

2 X 3 means choosing 2 races with 3 combinations.

Combination	Race 3	Race 5	Unit Bet
1	 Single Race		\$10
2		 Single Race	\$10
3	 +  All Up		\$10

Unit Bet: \$10
Total Bet: \$30

Benefit: Since All Up 2 x 3 consists of two bets on a single race, customers can collect a dividend if they are eligible for the bet dividend in either of the two races.



Real Case Example

28/04/2024 Sha Tin Race 3 and Race 5

All Up Example (2): 3 X 4

3 X 4 means choosing 3 races with 4 combinations.

Combination	Race 3	Race 5	Race 6	Unit bet
1		 All Up		\$10
2			 All Up	\$10
3			 All Up	\$10
4			 All Up	\$10

Unit bet: \$10
Total bet: \$40

All Up 3 x 4 does not consist of bets on single races, which is different to All Up 2 x 3. Customers can collect a dividend if they are eligible to the bet dividend in any two of the three races.

Benefit: Selecting more races in an All Up bet will mean a higher "multiplying effect" in the odds. The dividend will, therefore, be more attractive.

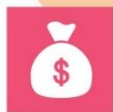
