## RACE HISTORY

The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup started out as the Queen's Silver Jubilee Challenge Cup, a 2230m handicap staged at Happy Valley in 1977 to celebrate the Silver Jubilee of Britain's Queen Elizabeth II. The distance and class of the race changed many times throughout the first 20 years until in 1997 it became a mile contest. In 2000, the Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup ("Challenge" was dropped from the race title in 1989) was upgraded to HKG3 level; two years later the contest achieved HKG2 status and in 2006 it was further upgraded to HKG1 level. The race distance was shortened to the current distance of 1400m in 2005. The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup was ranked equal 54th in the list of World's Top 100 G1 races in 2022.

The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup is now the second leg of the Hong Kong Speed Series, falling between the G1 Centenary Sprint Cup (first leg - 1200m) and G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize (final leg - 1200m). Able Friend produced a sensational win in this race in 2015 that placed the brilliant chestnut at the top of the LONGINES World's Best Racehorse Rankings. Beauty Generation, Hong Kong's Horse of the Year in 2017/18 & 2018/19, completed an unprecedented hat-trick three years in a row (2018, 2019 and 2020). Other past winners of the race include standout champions Ambitious Dragon, Lucky Nine, Good Ba Ba, Electronic Unicorn, Wellington and the great Silent Witness, who notched his record 17th consecutive career win in this race in 2005. The race's prize money has been increased to the current level of HK\$12 million in 2021.

## 2022 QUEEN'S SILVER JUBILEE CUP

The Richard Gibson-trained Wellington clinched a second Group 1 crown with rousing victory in the 2022 HK\$12 million Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (1400m) at Sha Tin.

Undimmed by the sodden conditions, Wellington reprised his best with a devastating finish, showing his trademark brilliance to prevail by three-quarters of a length to Ka Ying Star with race favourite Waikuku – who could not gain clear running until late before sprinting sharply when finally clear – a further neck away in third.

Badel savoured his second top-level win in Hong Kong on the son of All Too Hard.

"That was a strong and big win from the horse," the Frenchman said. "From that draw, I was only trying to get him to relax over 1400 (metres). He was absolutely relaxed and I was looking for a way out and as soon as I could I find some space and let him accelerate and he gave me his best turn of foot.

"He's certainly much more laidback, more relaxed than he used to be and that certainly helps the horse to stay the distance like he did today."
