RACE HISTORY

The Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup has a history that dates back to 1870. That original incarnation was titled the Champion Stakes and preceded the inauguration of England's Champion Stakes at Newmarket by seven years.

Sir Catchick Paul Chater, founding member and Club Chairman for 34 years from 1892, won the race five times. Upon his death in 1926 the Champion Stakes became the Chater Cup and was further retitled the Champions & Chater Cup in 1955.

The post-war years saw the contest staged over 2012m until the distance was lengthened to 2230m in 1973. In 1978 it became an 1800m event and retained that distance when the race moved to Sha Tin the following year.

When the Triple Crown Series was introduced in the 1991/92 season, the Champions & Chater Cup was installed as the third and final leg. It was granted HKG1 status and upped to 2200m with purse money of HK\$2 million. The distance was increased to its current 2400m in 1995, the year that the John Moore-trained pair Makarpura Star and Survey King dead-heated for victory.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club entered into a strategic partnership with Standard Chartered (Hong Kong) Limited in the 2009/10 season and in 2015 the race attained international G1 status. Prize money further increased to HK\$13 million in 2024.

Since 1975, multiple winners of the Champions & Chater Cup include four-time champion River Verdon (1991, 1992, 1993 & 1994) and three-time winners Super Win (1975, 1976 & 1977), Silver Lining (1978, 1979 & 1981) and Viva Pataca (2006, 2007 & 2009), two-time winners Co-Tack (1983 & 1984), Gay Eighties (1985 & 1986), Indigenous (1997 & 1998), Oriental Express (1999 & 2001), Blazing Speed (2014 & 2016), Exultant (2019 & 2020) and Russian Emperor (2022 & 2023).

In 2024/25, Voyage Bubble captured the Champions & Chater Cup to become the second horse in racing history after River Verdon (1993/94) to complete the Triple Crown.

Globe-trotting stayer Rebel's Romance, ridden by jockey William Buick, provided Charlie Appleby's first win in Hong Kong and became the first internationally trained horse to win this feature when the horse landed the 2024 edition.

2025 STANDARD CHARTERED CHAMPIONS & CHATER CUP

Rewriting Hong Kong racing history with a stunning triumph in the HK\$13 million G1 Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup (2400m) at Sha Tin, Voyage Bubble made light work of stamina concerns with a record-equalling performance to draw the highest praise from James McDonald and Ricky Yiu.

Given a perfect ride by McDonald, Voyage Bubble streaked to a three and a half lengths victory over Rubylot and Cap Ferrat in 2m 26.67s to become the second horse in Hong Kong racing history after River Verdon (1993/94) to complete the Triple Crown by winning the HK\$13 million G1 Stewards' Cup (1600m), HK\$13 million G1 Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup (2000m) and Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup in the same season.

Demolishing nine rivals, Voyage Bubble claimed a fifth Group 1 triumph as the 2023 BMW Hong Kong Derby (2000m) winner secured a HK\$10 million Triple Crown bonus, plus the winners' purse of HK\$7.28 million for the Sunshine And Moonlight Syndicate.

"I couldn't have dreamed of it panning out as well as that – that's once in a blue moon," McDonald said. "The stars aligned and with that sort of run, he was always going to be hard to beat – he was going to be hard to beat even without such a good run, but it all worked out. From the 600m, he tacked up beautifully, the pace increased, everything was smooth, nothing was cluttered up. I just had a really smooth run the whole way. He's a brilliant horse. He just keeps raising the bar and he keeps on surprising every time I ride him.

"So lucky to be riding him and he's just a brilliant racehorse. He just does everything you ask of him and he's so willing. He was on song today and he's just such a star. He just switches off and allows himself to get the distance so well and I just want to pay credit to the Yiu stable – they've done a remarkable job with this horse."

Yiu, who has trained a string of champion sprinters including Sacred Kingdom, Fairy King Prawn and Amber Sky, was jubilant after the win.

"Dreams came true, since I won the first two legs of the Triple Crown I started dreaming. Now today, dreams have come true – it's amazing," Yiu said. "The closer I looked at the race today, the closer I thought he would have a winning chance - he's done so well and his preparation was so good. He's pure athletic. If you look at him, you can tell he's a high-class racehorse. He's performed up from a sprint to the maximum distance in Hong Kong – he's a genius."
