

#### **Wondering through Old Town Central with Lunch**

Departure on 19 Sep (Tue) & 20 Sep (Wed)

Highlights: Spend your day with our knowledgeable local tour guide to the Western District, the old

section of Hong Kong Island. It is well-known for an abundance of local legends and historical buildings. It is a vibrant hub for culture, commerce and tourism in Hong Kong through the

ages.

Itinerary: Western District, Hollywood Street, Man Mo Temple, Dim Sum Lunch & Tai Kwun

To start off the visit of the **Western District**, we will explore the specialty shops selling salted fish, various dried seafood products, Ginseng, Bird's Nest and Herbal Medicine. This is a good way to learn about Chinese-traditional eating habits.

Hollywood Road, let's pause for a moment at Man Mo Temple which is over 170 years old and is officially declared as a monument in 2010. Its giant hanging incense coils makes for a pleasant contrast with the hectic pace of the city. Hollywood Road (Antique Street) is best-known for their curio and antiques shops. The Lascar Row (Cat Street) is full of vendors selling inexpensive pottery, jewelry, ornaments, coins, and carvings. These streets are of great fun to haggle and hunt for old trinkets.

Enjoy a **yummy dim sum lunch** at a local restaurant. Try our Mid-Levels Escalator and Walkway System where you can enjoy the local street scenes and distinctive city views built on a hillside. Dedicated **Tai Kwun** guided tour will allow you to explore the historical significance of this unique heritage site including the former Central Police Station Compound, Central Magistracy and Victoria Prison Compound.

Drop by the **Tsim Sha Tsui Promenade** to enjoy the magnificent Victoria Harbour and Hong Kong's iconic skyline. **The Avenue of Stars** is a boardwalk which honors the actors, filmmakers, producers and directors of Hong Kong's movie industry. You can even take a photo and interact with Bruce Lee who was the founder of Jeet Kune Do and was a Chinese Kung Fu superstar, by using Augmented Reality technology.

Take a ride on the HK **Star Ferry** to enjoy the magnificent Victoria Harbour view. Then catch the **Peak Tram to the Victoria Peak**, 552m above sea level, the highest point on Hong Kong Island. Unlike the other tour operator, our tour guide will accompany you for the Peak Circle Walk which offers stunning views of the city for Hong Kong Island's scenic north and south sides, and panoramic views of the city and the Victoria Harbour.

Lunch will be served on the Peak before heading to Aberdeen.

**Aberdeen** cannot be missed when you are in Hong Kong. It was a traditional fishing village. Many fishermen lived on various sized fishing boats moored in the typhoon shelter. With the decline of traditional fisheries industry, many fishermen have moved to live onshore. Let's charter a sampan boat, shuttling you back and forth to trace the former glory of a fishing village.



#### **New Territories Tour with Lunch**

Highlights: Spend your day with our knowledgeable local tour guide to the New Territories (N.T.), so

named when the British took more land from China in 1898. Often ignored by travelers who have little time to spare, the New Territories offers a diverse landscape that takes time to get

to know.

Fan Ling Wai walled village, Lunch & Lung Mei Beach.


We will be spending our time mostly in **Tai Po**, which lies in the northeast of the New Territories and has a history dating back to the Tang Dynasty (618 - 907).



First stop will be to the **Old District Office** (North) which was declared a monument in 1981. It is a typical colonial-style structure of the early 20th century. Finished in fine red bricks, with open verandahs and brick arches along its east and west elevations, it is a stately and elegant building. It has not been significantly altered. The antique fireplaces in the rooms are still well-preserved, which helps to bring out the historical character of the building.



**Tai Po** was one of the market towns that was selected to be expanded into a satellite town in 1972. Let's follow your guide to walk through the time capsule – Tai Wo Market Street!





Drive to **Tai Mei Tuk**, a favourite leisure spot for local residents for activities like barbecue, fly kites, go cycling, water spot or fishing. There are more than a dozen roadside restaurants for us to choose for lunch. Afterwards, we will walk up to the main dam of Plover Cove Reservoir, to enjoy spectacular views of the reservoir on one side and Tolo Harbour on the other. We can take a stroll on the Lung Mei Beach too.



### **Lantau Island Explorer with Vegetarian Lunch**

Departure on 22 Sep (Fri)

Highlights: Lantau adventure and enjoy the tranquil harmony of nature. Coach ride to Tung Chung Ngong

Ping 360 Cable car station, with bird's eye view of our airport, green mountain, along with the highest point to see one of the tallest seated outdoor bronze Buddha statue and Venice of the

East - Tai O Fishing Village.

Itinerary: Ngong Ping 360 village, Po Lin Monastery and Tai O Fishing Village.

#### **Ngong Ping**

The experience starts with a 25-minute cable car ride from Tung Chung to Ngong Ping 360. The village is a replica of ancient shopping street of China.

A walk from Ngong Ping Plaza takes you to the century-old Po Lin Monastery, which was built in 1906. Its Main Shrine Hall of the Buddha, Hall of Skanda Bodhisattva, Bell Tower and Drum Tower are arranged symmetrically, offering a pleasant environment to linger in before setting off on a hike. Opposite the monastery, the majestic Tian Tan Buddha is one of the largest outdoor seated bronze Buddha statues in the world.

#### Tai O

Coach dashes to the authentic fishing village - Tai O, which is famed for its generations of fishers who built their houses on stilts. The stilted houses are interconnected and form a tight knitted community on the water.



### **Dragon's Back Hiking Tour**

Departure on 23 Sep (Sat)

Highlights: The last leg of the Hong Kong Trail, this meandering path on the ridge of Dragon's

Back is widely hailed as one of Hong Kong's best urban hikes. Besides its attractive name, Dragon's Back has a sightseeing platform near its peak that provides truly

spectacular views of southern Hong Kong Island and its shoreline.

Itinerary: Pick up from Kerry Hotel, coach to the starting point, hike for 2.5 hours and lunch at

Shek O. Average hiking time: 2.5 hours | Distance: About 8.5 km |

Difficulty: Moderate

Duration: 09:00 – 16:00 (7 hours)

Tour Price: HK\$780/US\$101 per person (minimum 10 persons)







Start your hike uphill along the well-trodden path from Cape Collinson Road to To Tei Wan. A cool path takes you through shady groves of bamboo and lush woodlands accompanied by birdsong, eventually, emerging into open hillsides covered with wild azaleas and rose myrtle. Upon reaching the spectacular Shek O Country Park, you will follow the rugged undulating spinal ridge of the Dragon's Back. The walk is filled with breathtaking views of the dazzling seas, the distant Nine Pins Islands, sandy Big Wave Bay, Tai Tam Harbour and both the Stanley and Red Hill peninsulas.

The walk concludes with a stroll down through shaded tunnels of exotic flora. We'll catch our coach from **To Tei Wan** to a beautiful sandy beach at **Shek O**.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a favourite Thai seafood restaurant. After which the coach will bring you back to the hotel.



### **Cooking Class Tour with lunch**
